

Saul and Obama

Israel was the people called and set apart by Yah to be a people unto his name and through which the savior of the world would come. To keep them pure from idol worship, pagan gods and following the dictates of the fallen nature in man's heart, he raised up a man to lead them in his ways. Yah set up a set up laws, ordinances and priesthood through Moses, the man of Yah, to show them the way man should live and treat each other. In our day the people have rejected Yah being over them and demanded a king like the other countries. They all clamored after Obama for to make him president. While he campaigned he told them what his plans were, but they did not understand that he wanted to be a king over the whole world, not just a president in the United States of America.

Barack Hussein Obama II came from a humble background just as Saul did, but he was not of the lineage of kings either. As I foresaw in my dream, "The End of Democracy" the people kept insisting he be president, so Yah allowed it. Remember the scriptures say he sets in place those in positions of power. He is still in control of man's affairs. He allowed this just as he allowed Saul to be king in the Old Testament. It was part of his plan in type and shadow of these end times. We see the things in Saul's life playing out in the life of Obama.

Saul had a real experience with Yah and was changed, Obama declared that he was a Christian and had an experience with Yah. Because of his position, power and self-importance Saul became evil in his heart and an evil spirit took control of him. Obama soon left behind his Christianity and began to manifest his muslim roots. His desire to bring in a "One World Government" and be the first king over the entire world possesses him now. He laid it all out in his speech at the United Nations Meeting for the entire world to hear. If there was ever any doubt before, there can be none as to where he is leading us.

With his gift of charisma and his pleasing ways he is well on his way to be king, not only of America, but also of the whole world. This he will accomplish by bring all the world leaders together with his persuasive words to make them one nation, all equal and all under his authority or kingship. of the true King of kings, just as Saul was only the forerunner of the ligament king of Israel.

David, of the tribe of Judah, would eventually become the anointed king of Israel. This was Yah's true king for the people at that time. Notice what Yah said about Saul when he was talking to Samuel, "*He will govern my people*". The people ask for a king, but Yah gave them a governor. Saul will be a king to the people, but only a governor in Yah's eyes. The people wanted Obama as a president, but he fancies himself a king. In the eyes of the people he plans on becoming a king, as he believes he is destined to be in his heart, but he will never be a true king, just as Saul was never a true king.

When Saul became evil and no longer honored Yah in his heart it grieved Samuel deeply and he wept and mourned as one who lost a son. Now Yah said to Samuel, "*How long will you mourn for Saul, since I have rejected him as King over Israel?*" Then he told him to go and make a sacrifice at Bethlehem and invite Jesse and his sons. "***I have chosen one of his sons to be King.***"

From time to time in scripture when Yah wanted to move a people into his divine plan he would allow a ruler to rise up to move them out of their comfort zone and into his divine will. They had prospered in Egypt even though they were slaves and had become many. But, Yah wanted Israel to begin their migration toward the Promised Land so they found their life in Egypt under Pharaoh so miserable that they cried out to him to deliver them. Pharaoh became a pawn to accomplish his will and start the people on their journey. Reluctantly they started out with visions of the leeks and garlic of Egypt in their heart, not the vision of the promise Land.

After World War I Yah again wanted to move his people into the Promise Land he had prepared for them. They, too, were reluctant to leave because he had blessed them and they had become prosperous in Europe where they had been dispersed because of sin and disobedience. Hitler became his pawn and drove the Jews out of their comfort zone. Many refused to heed the call of the Spirit for them to move on in his divine plan and they died at Hitler's hand. After they were delivered they went and began to live in the inheritance Yah had promised Abraham.

On this side of the cross we have a better inheritance than did the posterity of Abraham. Theirs was a literal physical inheritance. For those that are born, not of Abraham, but of incorruptible seed through YahShua Massiyah, ours is a spiritual one and that inheritance is the Kingdom of Heaven, our spiritual Promise Land. In Yah divine plan we are to progress in him following him into the kingdom.

Today, Obama no longer honors Yah in his heart just as Saul did. He was just appealing to the religious spirit in America to get the votes. You can see it on Television and hear people weeping and mourning over what they see happening in Washington. They are crying for deliverance like those in Egypt. Life has become intolerable to them under Obama's administration. They, along with Yah's chosen sons destined for kingship, are praying and sending up petitions about the evil they see in Obama as he strives to destroy democracy and bring him to kingship. Yah's answer is, "Only in his own heart and in the heart of his people will he be a king. **I have a chosen** one that will be king, and not only that, but he will be King of kings." Obama is the forerunner, just as Saul was the forerunner for David. He was just an organizer and set up the order and form of government suited for a king, but was really never king of it.

Obama was an organizer from the beginning and many have stated that fact on the national news. He is only a governor and his inability is bringing an end to democracy. This sounds bad, but democracy would never allow for a king. It has to fall and be swallowed up in what is now called by news media, the “New World Order”.
